THE ORIGIN

VERDECA IS AN ANCIENT WHITE GRAPE VARIETY OF PROBABLE GREEK ORIGIN, WIDESPREAD IN PUGLIA FOR A LONG TIME AND IS SO CALLED FOR THE INTENSE GREEN COLOR OF THE BUNCH, WHICH IS FOUND IN THE NUANCES OF THE WINE.

ITS DIFFUSION IS MAINLY CONCENTRATED IN THE WINE-GROWING AREAS OF THE PROVINCES OF BARI, TARANTO AND BRINDISI.

GRAPES: 100% VERDECA ORIGIN: PUGLIA

COLOR: STRAW YELLOW WINE TENDING TOWARDS GREENISH.

BOUQUET: THE NOSE IS DELICATE AND PLEASANTLY FRUITY, WITH HINTS OF PINEAPPLE AND PLEASANT CITRUS NUANCES WITH HINTS OF BERGAMOT.

GASTRONOMIC COMBINATIONS: EXCELLENT PAIRING OF Verdeca wine with fish dishes and fresh cheeses.

TASTE: IT HAS A FRESH, SAVORY AND PERSISTENT TASTE. Alcohol by volume: 12.5%
